

**Dale Sanitary District 1
Regular Monthly Meeting
August 15, 2017
6:30 P.M.**

The regular monthly meeting of Dale Sanitary District 1, Town of Dale, Wisconsin was called to order on August 15, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. by James Wight. In attendance for the Dale Sanitary District were James Wight, President, Judith Sommerfield-Fox, Vice President; and Charles Zehner, Secretary/Treasurer; Cornelius Van Voorhis, Plant Manager.

There were no citizens in attendance.

Plant Manager's Report. We have not yet heard from Great Lakes regarding televising in Alzena Estates.

The dissolved oxygen numbers are improved with just less than seven (7). Approximately 30 hours was put into duck weed removal, which improved the numbers. With the numbers improved, a dissolved oxygen meter was borrowed from the Village of Shiocton. We can now keep better track of the levels as they are now being checked five days a week.

It is coming up on the time to work on the diffusers again. Plant manager will check into getting a new set of membranes with clamps and tools. In 2009 when they were last purchased, the cost was \$420. The Plant Manager will work directly with the supplier to get a new set. He will also check with the engineer about cost of replacement.

At the last meeting we talked about the possibility of a mini excavator. The Board will investigate the cost of manual labor versus an excavator purchase. This item will be held open until more information is available.

Plant manager is working with Viola Environmental Services regarding sludge removal. The estimates given had missing items such as permits, etc. This information will be updated and included in the estimate. Sludge will be removed from the polishing pond. Sludge was last removed 2010 and was removed from all three ponds.

Crane engineering came out and did trouble shooting and repairs on the hour meters and calibrated the flow meters at the plant.

The plant manager has been working on the laterals and where they lie with house numbers. There were issues with leaking and flowing laterals. One address on Wheeler Road will be checked as there appears to be an issue.

There was two locates for Digger's Hotline this month.

Budget Review. The Budget report was distributed. A motion was made to approve to the report and seconded; motion carried.
