

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
JANUARY 14, 2018
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, 2nd Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Building Inspector Jim Emmons, and residents present.

During public input, Hortonville Village Administrator Dave DeTroye introduced himself and asked if anyone had questions for him.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve a certified survey map for Dave and Christine Schuelke, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried. The map was preliminarily approved at the January 7, 2019 Planning Commission Meeting. A shared driveway was in existence prior to approval of the map. The division is the final one allowed.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve bartender licenses for Timilsina Samjhana, Dipi Neupane and Hari Joshi from Dale BP, provided all paperwork is complete and fees paid, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

After fifty eight years of service, forty of which were as Fire Chief, Chief Jim Emmons has retired from the Fire Department. A huge Thank You to Jim for so many years of service.

Chad Degal was sworn in as the new Fire Chief.

Attorney Forsgren reported that he and Constable Gadamus have been reviewing and making revisions to the dog ordinance. A new ordinance will be approved at a future meeting.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve payment of property tax refund checks through February 28, 2019, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Fire Chief Emmons reported seven calls for the month of December; six first responder and one accident. There were seventy eight calls in 2018; fifty eight in Dale and twenty in Caledonia.

Building Inspector Emmons reported eight new home permits were issued in 2018.

The Planning Commission met on January 7, 2019. One map was reviewed and preliminarily approved. The next meeting is scheduled for February 4, 2019, provided there are items for an agenda.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve minutes of the December meetings, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

During public input a resident raised concern about furniture left out in a residence front yard for a significant amount of time.

The Spring Primary Election will be held February 19, 2019 at the Dale Municipal Building. Polls will be open from 7:00a.m. – 8:00p.m. Only residents living in the New London School District will be allowed to vote, as New London School Board Members are the only candidates on the February ballot.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Another reminder to residents that have trees in the right of way hanging over the road are asked to please trim them. Thank you to all residents that have already done so.

Supervisor Degal reported that he will be scheduling a meeting with the Town of Caledonia Board Members to discuss fire services.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #17611 – 17685, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
