

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 11, 2019
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Building Inspector Jim Emmons and residents present.

Seth Cowan, a representative for Chris Martinson, candidate for New London School Board was present.

Jim and Elayne Emmons thanked everyone involved in planning the retirement party for him. After fifty eight years, forty of which were as chief, Jim retired from the fire department.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to table a new dog ordinance until March, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Fire Chief Degal reported seven calls for the month of January; five first responder, one Co2 call and one shed fire.

Building Inspector Emmons reported no new home permits were issued in January.

Constable Gadamus requested permission to attend a training session titled "Positive Solutions for Dog Aggression." The seven hour class will count towards the thirty required hours to hold her Humane Officer license. Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to grant permission to Constable Gadamus to attend the training session, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. The cost of the class is \$85.00.

The planning commission met on February 4, 2019. A potential cluster subdivision was discussed.

A noise ordinance and an ordinance allowing ATV's on town roads will be discussed in the near future. Attorney Forsgren will compose drafts for both.

Roads Report:

- Cloverleaf and Winchester Road sign is missing.
- Reminder – No snow should be plowed across or placed on roadways at any time. The practice of leaving piles of snow on public highways after plowing private driveways or parking lots creates a hazard for the traveling public and creates a problem for our road plowing operation. Per Wisconsin Statutes 346.94(5), it is illegal for persons to leave deposits of any materials on highways.
- Road bids will be published in March.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve minutes of the January meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

- First State Bank in Dale will be closing. Because of this, they will no longer be used as a tax collection site.

- Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal reported the last check number used to pay bills in January was #17685. Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills starting with #17686 – 17765, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
