

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
MARCH 13, 2017  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons, Engineer Ben Zeier and town residents.

During public input John Heideman introduced himself as a candidate for the New London School Board. He spoke about his background and where he stands on issues within the district.

MDR Lions Club will hold a Project Lions Blanket Day on April 29, 2017, 9:00am – 1:00pm at the Dale Municipal Building.

No Outagamie County Sheriff was present.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a Tax Refund Interception Program (TRIP) agreement with Gold Cross Ambulance, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. The program allows AmeriCollect, Gold Cross's collection agency with the help of the Department of Revenue to file a Tax intercept request for unpaid services. All municipalities within the consortium have signed the agreement.

Mike Lehman introduced himself and requested the use of Daufen Park baseball diamond for the Dale, Medina, Readfield softball league. The league has used the park for many years under the direction of Patti Grossman. Mr. Lehman will be the new contact for the program.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve a bartender's license for Ann Du Chateau provided all fees are paid and paperwork is complete, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve the purchase of a new laptop for the treasurer, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried. Monies for a replacement have been in the budget for the past two years.

Fire Chief Emmons reported nine calls for the month of February; six first responders, two accidents and one semi fire.

Building Inspector Emmons issued two permits in the month of February. Both were for alterations to existing homes.

Roads Report:

- Road projects will be bid in April
- Repairs have been made to road signs around town.
- Pot holes will be filled as soon as weather permits.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve minutes of the February meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Outagamie County Clerk Lori O'Bright is working with Outagamie County Finance Department to replace aging election equipment. The county may agree to a onetime 50/50 split of the cost, it would be advantageous to replace the equipment at that time.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to pay bills #16632 – 16675, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.
