

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
MARCH 11, 2019  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Building Inspector Jim Emmons and residents present.

During public input, Lynn Hicks thanked the board for keeping the roads clean and safe this winter.

Outagamie County Sheriff's Deputy Rolain was present.

Sanitary District President Jim Wight submitted a resignation letter. His last day will be March 19, 2019. On February 19, 2019, Chairperson Wunderlich spoke to Sanitary District Secretary Chuck Zehner about having candidates to fill the vacant position at the March 11, 2019 Board Meeting. No one from the Sanitary District was present, nor were there any candidates. Supervisor Degal made a motion to appoint Doug Wunderlich to fill the remaining two years of Jim Wight's six year term, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. Chairperson Wunderlich abstained.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to table an ordinance for the use of snowmobiles, all terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles on town roads, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. The issue will be discussed further at the Annual Meeting, April 16, 2019 at 7:00p.m.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve revisions to Ordinance 2:02, Regulation and Licensing of Dogs and Other Animals, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a Loud and Unnecessary Noise Ordinance, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Road bids for the completion of Midway Road will be opened in April.

Fire Chief Degal reported five calls for the month of February; two first responder calls, one house fire, one car accident and one snowmobile accident.

Building Inspector Emmons reported that there were no new home permits issued in February.

Constable Gadamus reported she issued an Abatement Order and Citation to Arleen Weyland.

There was no Planning Commission meeting in February.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve minutes from February meetings, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

The Spring Election is April 2, 2019. Polls are open from 7:00a.m. – 8:00p.m.

Treasurer's Report:

- The onsite audit is scheduled for March 28, 2019.
- Because First State Bank in Dale will be closing, bank manager, Peter Kurth waived the purchase price for a scanner that will be used to make deposits to the bank, along with the monthly fee as a convenience.
- Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal reported the last check number used to pay bills in February was 17765. Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #17766 – 17803, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.
