

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
APRIL 9, 2018  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons, Constable Sandy Gadamus and residents present.

An Outagamie County Officer was present. He reported that on March 24<sup>th</sup>, there were a string of mailboxes damaged on Cedar and Depot Roads. There were no updates in the case.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a certified survey map for Kearn, Tesch and Strong, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. Kelvin Tesch purchased a small piece of land to add to his existing parcel on lot one. Merton and Marlea Strong purchased a small piece to add to their existing parcel on lot two. Both were done to straighten lot lines and clean up the division between their parcels and the farm land to the north purchased by Jeff Kearn.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to reappoint Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw and Treasurer Sandy Noffke for a three year term, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve a bartender's license for Jane Silver at Dale Mini Mart, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

**Fire Chief's Report:**

- A few changes were made to the plans for the new fire truck. The truck is tentatively scheduled for delivery in September or October.
- Fire Chief Emmons reported five calls for the month of March; two first responder calls, one vehicle accident, one smoke alarm and one chimney fire.

Building Inspector Emmons issued one new home permit and four permits for alterations to existing properties.

The intersection of Hwy 45 and State Road 96 will be closed from May 1<sup>st</sup> – August 1<sup>st</sup>. A roundabout will be constructed. Shaky Lake and School Roads are for local traffic only. The official detour route set by Wisconsin DOT is Hwy 110, Hwy 10 and Hwy 76.

Tire Recycle Day is April 14, 2018 from 9:00a.m. to Noon.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve the minutes of March meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

The onsite audit was performed on March 15<sup>th</sup> and went very well. Chairperson Wunderlich spoke to the auditor. She was very complimentary about the job Sandy is doing in the treasurer position.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #17209-17238, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
