

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
APRIL 13, 2020
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m. with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw and two residents present.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to have Borsche Roofing complete necessary roof repairs on the Municipal Building and Fire Hall for the sum of \$8480.00, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to replace all of the downspouts on the front side of the Municipal Building and Fire Hall at the price of \$520 for each long section and \$480 for each short section, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Due to COVID 19, the Annual Meeting will not take place on April 21, 2020. We are waiting for guidance from the Wisconsin Town's Association on when we can hold the meeting. The rescheduled date will be posted on the Town of Dale website.

Fire Chief Degal reported eight calls in the month of March; seven first responder calls and one for a barn fire.

No building permits were reported in March.

Roads Report:

- Some cold patching has started.
- Winter damage to Cloverleaf, School and Greendale Roads will be repaired soon.
- Brush cutting is in progress
- Alzena Subdivision roads are in need of being chip sealed.

Parks Report:

- Supervisor Laabs will cut the wildflower patch and look into repairs of the baseball diamond sign.
- Bathrooms in both parks will not be opened until the State lessens restrictions and opens.
- There will be no Park Work Day this year.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve minutes from the March meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Clerks Report:

- In response to COVID 19, Tire Recycle has been rescheduled for July 11th, 8:00am – Noon.
- Open Book is scheduled for May 27th, 3:00 – 5:00pm and will be by telephone appointment only.
- Board of Review is scheduled for June 17th, 6:00 – 8:00pm

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich was approached by a resident requesting the Town not allow "engine braking" by semis on Hwy 96. After discussion, the members felt there was not enough semi traffic to justify the expense.

Supervisor Degal reported the last check used to pay bills in March was #18351. Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #18352 – 18384, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
