

**TOWN BOARD MEETING  
MAY 8, 2017  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons, Engineer Ben Zeier and town residents present.

Outagamie County Sheriff's Deputy Rolain was present.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve Earth Sense Energy Systems replacing their existing permanent company sign with a marquee sign with the agreement that they will eliminate the banner on the front of the blue flat iron building and limit the use of banners on the east and west sides of their business to two weeks a month, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

The sanitary district made a request to use the Municipal Building to hold their monthly meetings on the third Tuesday of the month at 6:30pm. Town board members asked to have the town's quarterly sanitary charge waived, in exchange for use of the hall. Jim Wight stated they will discuss the option at their next meeting. A request was also made to gain access to the Town website. A better option was decided to make a sanitary district page on the website and Jim Wight would forward updates to the clerk to be added. A new dropbox will be added to the front of the municipal building to collect sanitary payments. Residents should no longer use the Town of Dale gray dropbox for sanitary payments.

The Dale Medina Readfield softball league will be holding an end of season tournament in Daufen Park, the last weekend of July. Two days will be reserved, the second being for a rainout date. The Sandy Knoll 4H Club will be selling concessions.

Ray and Chris Samson owners of Jimmer's Bar will be blacktopping their parking lot because of ice issues from this past winter. They asked if the Town would pay for paving the easement driveway connected to their parking lot, owned by the Town through Cornerstone Park. Supervisor Laabs made a motion to pay \$1500 for blacktopping the driveway, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

**Fire Chief's Report:**

- Fire Chief Emmons reported ten calls for the month of April; one billable fire, mutual aid to Ellington, mutual aid to Winchester, one ATV accident, six first responder calls.
- Specs for the new pumper truck will be worked on Thursday.

Building Inspector Emmons reported four new home permits for the month of April.

Constable Gadamus attended a training session in Green Bay.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve minutes of the April meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

**Roads Report:**

- Kelldale Court was paved.
- Shouldering work has started throughout town.

- MCC plans to start grind and reclaim projects the first week of June.

- Park Work Day is Saturday, May 20, starting at 8:00am. Volunteers are appreciated!

- Mulch was ordered for park work day.
- Bathrooms were unlocked and water turned on in both parks.
- A tree will be donated in memory of Jean Kelly to be planted in Armitage Park in Medina.

- New London School Board member Chris Martinson attended the meeting and gave updates about the district and details of changes that will be put in place.
- Pine Grove Cemetery made a request for assistance in the amount of \$500. Chairperson Wunderlich encouraged Chuck Zehner to make efforts for the cemetery to become self-reliant.
