

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
JUNE 8, 2020  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Constable Sandy Gadamus and residents present.

Cordell Schroeder spoke about the Dale Historical Society. There are many donated items that Cordell would like proper storage for. Her vision is to ultimately have somewhere to properly display everything for residents to enjoy the history of Dale. She is also looking for volunteers interested in helping with the Historical Society. Anyone interested in volunteering can contact the Dale Municipal Building.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve revisions to the Building Permit Fee Schedule, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion that 2020 liquor, bartender and cigarette licenses as listed on the agenda and published in the Post Crescent be approved as long as all paperwork is in order and fees are paid, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Renters are asked to please follow CDC Guidelines pertaining to COVID 19 when using the Municipal Building and parks.

The Dale Fire and Rescue fireworks have been cancelled this year. The annual raffle will still take place virtually.

Yourr Electric will be upgrading the park bathroom lighting to LED at \$15.00 per light and also adding motion sensors.

Fire Chief Degal reported five calls for the month of May; two brush fires, one CO2 detector and two first responder calls, both related to COVID 19.

Six building permits were issued in May. None of them were for new homes.
