

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
JULY 9, 2018
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons, Constable Sandy Gadamus and residents present.

Public Input:

- A resident on School Road complained about increase in traffic because of construction on Hwy 96 and 45. Signs and barricades have been in place since the construction began. There has also been an increase in police presence and they are issuing citations to drivers going over the speed limit.
- Lynn Hicks questioned the start date for construction on Degal Avenue. Per the contract with MCC, the project needs to be completed by September 1st, so it will be done whenever their schedule permits.
- Lynn Hicks also reported that damage happened to Kelldale Court by Outagamie County Road equipment. Equipment was parked on Kelldale Court during County Hwy M construction.
- Chris Martinsen, New London School Board Member was present to give an update on what the Board has been working on. He said there may be a referendum on the November ballot for upgrades to some district schools. Public forums will be held to discuss options, July 12th and 16th. Mr. Martinsen encourages residents to contact a school board member with questions or concerns.

Outagamie County Sheriff's Officer Brooks was present.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a sign permit for Ryan Richeson of Appleton Snow and Lawn Patrol, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. The permit was reviewed by the entire board because the property was granted a special exception last year. Mr. Richeson again said retail would not happen from the location. The reason for the sign is customer awareness. Chairperson Wunderlich advised Mr. Richeson to contact the Outagamie County Highway Department to ensure he is abiding by county setbacks.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a bartender's license for Tammy Winton from Route 96, provided all paperwork is complete and fees are paid, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

A meeting took place with Outagamie County Highway Commissioner Dean Steingraber and his foreman Randy, to discuss potentially having Outagamie County provide snowplowing services for a portion of the town roads. The board is looking at options, but have not made a final decision. Mr. Steingraber will get some information to us based on our needs. They have a lot resources that would have been very useful during the big snowstorm in April.

Fire Chief Emmons reported seven calls in the month of June; four first responder, one train accident and two accidents.

The 2018 Annual Fireworks was a great success. Thank you to everyone that helped make it happen. A tremendous amount of work is put into the event! Volunteers are always appreciated.

Building Inspector Emmons reported one new home permit was issued in June.

Road Report:

- Speed limit signs will be put up on Cedar Road. The speed limit is 45mph. Several residents have shown concern that people are driving too fast.

- Pot holes have been patched and will continue to be patched as needed.
- Unsure of a specific date that town paving projects will begin. They include roads in the village and the parking lot by the Municipal Building.
- Ditch mowing continues.
- State Road 96 will be chip sealed on July 18, 19, and 20th

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve the minutes of June meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

- Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
- The MFL payment was much lower than the amount in the budget. Treasurer Noffke will continue to try to contact someone that can offer an explanation as to why.
- The 2% Dues payment was double of what it was supposed to be. The State notified municipalities of the error, took payments back and will send new amount when the error is settled.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #17334-17377, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.
