

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
JULY 13, 2020

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw and residents present.

Fire Chief Degal reported ten calls for the month of June; eight first responder calls, one car accident and one smoke false alarm.

Seven building permits were issued in June. None of them for new homes.

The Planning Commission met on July 6<sup>th</sup>. The two certified survey maps approved at the beginning of the meeting were reviewed.

To improve circulation in the park bathrooms, new fans will be installed when Yourr Electric also upgrades the lighting.
