

DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 8, 2016
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons and town residents present.

Outagamie County Sheriff Deputy Rolain was in attendance. Deputy Rolain reminded residents the nonemergency number is 920-832-5000 and you can remain anonymous.

During public input Todd and Michelle Brocker voiced concern about a stop sign at the intersection of Hwy T and Cloverleaf that is obstructed by trees. Outagamie County will be notified.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a special exception request for a kennel license for Todd and Michelle Brocker, seconded by Supervisor Degal. A public hearing was held at 6:30pm. Letters were mailed to nearby residents. Many, but not all were in favor of the special exception. Constable Sandy Gadamus spoke with Outagamie County and also visited the Brocker's home. The proposed kennel would have garage doors to minimize noise if needed.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a certified survey map for Brandon Selle, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

The State of Wisconsin currently has a law prohibiting people from crossing railroad tracks on foot. Supervisor Laabs made a motion to sign resolution # 01-2016 to rescind the railroad trespass law, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried. The Village of Hortonville passed a similar resolution to rescind the law. The resolution will be mailed to the offices of the Governor and state officials.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve resolution #02-2016, Just Fix it, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. The resolution was generated by the Wisconsin Towns Association to encourage the Governor and state officials to improve ways of funding road construction. The resolution will be mailed to the offices of the Governor and state officials.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve a bartender's license for Seth Fink and Karl White provided paperwork is complete and fees are paid, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to table discussion about fence questions on Lauden Lane, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve Veteran's perpetual care fund reimbursement for Dale Union Cemetery, Pine Grove Cemetery and South Medina Cemetery seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chief Emmons reported twelve calls for the month of July; nine first responder calls, two accidents and one automatic false alarm.

Building Inspector Emmons reported one new home permit was issued in July.

The Planning Commission met on August 1, 2016. A CSM for Brandon Selle was reviewed and preliminarily approved. The commission also reviewed a dog kennel special exception for Todd and Michelle Brocker.

Supervisor Laabs reported that he attended a meeting with other local officials to discuss the future of Hwy 45 and 96. He was informed a roundabout will be constructed sometime in 2018 and will take approximately four months to complete.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve minutes of July 2016 meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to pay bills #16232 – 16277, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
