

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 14, 2020  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw and residents present.

An Outagamie County Officer was present and reported that they will be using four grants for traffic stops in October; OWI, seatbelt use, speeding and focusing on Hwy 15 and Hwy 96.

A budget work meeting has been scheduled for Monday, October 12, 2020 at 7:45pm. A Public Budget Hearing will be held Monday, November 9, 2020 at 6:00p.m.

The annual Halloween parade is scheduled for October 31<sup>st</sup>, starting at 1:00p.m. at Daufen Park. Trick or Treat hours are 1:30 – 4:30p.m.

**Fire Chief's Report:**

- Chief Degal reported fourteen calls for the month of August.
- The annual Cancer Walk has been postponed until spring.
- The new truck and trailer will be getting decaled soon.

Six building permits were issued in August. One of them for a new home.

Automatic touchless paper towel dispensers, automatic soap dispensers and touchless faucets have all been installed in the Municipal Building, Fire Hall and the two town parks. Money from the Routes to Recovery federal grant was used. The Routes to Recovery Grant is being used for reimbursement for eligible Covid 19 related expenses. Each municipality has been allocated funds depending on their population; \$48,000 for the Town of Dale. Any unused funds will be given to other municipalities throughout the state. Four laptops were also purchased to accommodate virtual meetings that now take place due to the pandemic.

The Planning Commission did not meet in September.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve minutes from the August meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #18580 – 18629, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
