

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 10, 2022
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Clerk Jenny Hunt, Constable Sandy Gadamus and residents present.

During public input Lynn Hicks asks about the 2022 Halloween parade. The parade is scheduled for Saturday, October 29, at 2:00pm. Trick or Treat will follow until 5:00pm.

A representative from Sandy Knoll 4H was present requesting the use of the Municipal Building March 25, 2023 for their annual egg hunt and December 3, 2023 for their Christmas party and gift wrapping. The request will be added to the November agenda.

No Outagamie County Officer was present.

Two contracts for garbage collection were reviewed; one from GFL, the town's existing provider and a seconded from Harter's. Tim from GFL was present at the September Board Meeting. A request was made for a few changes to the GFL contract and those were made. GFL is charging \$9.20 per cart per month plus the tipping fees at the landfill. There will be a 3% raise each year. Harter's proposal was for \$11.00 per cart per month. Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a contract with GFL for garbage collection, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to sign a Mutual Resolution to Terminate "Fire Protection Agreement Between the Town of Dale and Town of Caledonia", dated December 21, 2009, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a new five year agreement to provide fire protection services to the Town of Caledonia, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. Fire services will now be provided to the entire Town of Caledonia at a rate of \$41,000 per year, with a yearly 3% increase.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve bartender's licenses for Mandy Hockers and Jennifer Heuer at JT'S on 96, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Fire Chief Degal reported seven calls for the month of September; four first responder calls, one car accident, one grasshopper in a biker's ear, one mutual aid for a structure fire in the Town of Clayton.

Twenty building permits were issued in the month of September; One new home.

The Planning Commission did not meet in October.

Two culverts are coming up out of the road on Black Otter Court. Immel Excavating will be replacing both with elliptical culverts and Kurt's Services will be patching the area.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve the minutes of the September meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills starting with check #19718 -19746, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, motion carried.
