

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 12, 2018
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons, Attorney Erik Forsgren and residents present.

Russel Miller was present with questions concerning his parcel. He currently has a map showing a road outlined. There is not an actual road there, it is reserved for a potential future road. He was advised to leave it as is in case he needs access in the future to the back of his property. No easement is needed because of the mapped road.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a three year contract with Schenck to provide audit services for 2018, 2019 and 2020, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. Each year there is a 2% price increase.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the final payment to MCC for completion of the 2018 paving project, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Attorney Forsgren will compose a letter to residents that have trees that need trimming. Many trees are in the right of way and have become problematic for school bus drivers, who have contacted the Town and asked for the issue to be addressed.

Fire Chief Emmons reported twelve calls in the month of October; nine first responder calls, one smoke detector, one roll over and one wire down.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve minutes of October meetings, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #17524-17580, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.
