

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
NOVEMBER 9, 2020  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw and Treasurer Sandy Noffke present. Attorney Erik Forsgren and Constable Sandy Gadamus were not present.

An Outagamie County Officer was not present.

No public input.

The Public Budget Hearing is scheduled for December 14, 2020, 6:00p.m. at the Dale Municipal Building.

Fire Chief Chad Degal reported five calls for the month of October; four EMS calls and one electric line down.

Ten building permits and four culvert permits were issued in October; three of which were for new homes.

Roads Report:

- Cold patch and ditch mowing are done for the year.
- A cul de sac at the end of Depot Road is complete.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve minutes from the October meetings, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

- A Letter of Engagement for auditing services was signed with Clifton Larsen formerly named Schenck. Clifton Larsen completes the annual audit.
- Treasurer Noffke reported an extra payment in the amount of \$19,121.00 will be paid towards the pumper fire truck loan. The extra money came from a shared tax revenue with Outagamie County. At the beginning of 2020 Outagamie County imposed an additional .5% sales tax.
- Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

The Planning Commission did not meet in November.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #18661 – 18690, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. Supervisor Degal noted the last check used to pay bills in October was #18660.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
