

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 14, 2022
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Clerk Jenny Hunt, Constable Sandy Gadamus and residents present.

An Outagamie County Officer was present.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to give Pine Grove Cemetery Association one thousand dollars to assist with 2023 expenses, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve Sandy Knoll 4H Club to use the Municipal Building at the \$20 rate on March 25, 2023 and December 3, 2023, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve a bartender's license for Melanie Chally (JT's on 96), provided all paperwork is complete and fees are paid, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Fire Chief Degal reported thirteen calls for the month of October; seven first responder calls, three accidents, one gas leak, one control burn and one combine fire.

Nine building permits were issued in the month of October; One new home.

Roads Report:

- Ditch mowing is complete for the year.
- The salter and plow have been installed on the town truck for the season.
- The Short Road cul de sac will be started after WE Energies completes moving wires and electric boxes.

The Planning Commission did not meet in November.

Treasurer's Report:

- Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills starting with check #19747 - 19782, check number 19774 was cancelled, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.
