

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
DECEMBER 10, 2018
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Constable Sandy Gadamus, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons, Attorney Erik Forsgren and residents present.

Outagamie County Sheriff's Deputy Rolain was present.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve a bartender's license for Canyon Hughes (Route 96), provided all fees are paid and paperwork is complete, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to allow Treasurer Noffke to pay year end bills, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Fire Chief Emmons reported four first responder calls for the month of November.

Building Inspector Emmons reported no new home permits were taken out in November.

Constable Gadamus reported that she began the process of updating Ordinance 2:02, Regulation and Licensing Dogs.

Supervisor Laabs will be removing dead trees from Daufen Park.
