

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
DECEMBER 12, 2022
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor and Fire Chief Chad Degal, Attorney Erik Forsgren, Clerk Jenny Hunt, Constable Sandy Gadamus and residents present.

An Outagamie County Officer was present. He reported an increase in catalytic converter thefts in the Fox Valley.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to approve a certified survey map for Robert and Joyce Much, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried. The CSM is all of tax parcel 060072900, 060072903 and 060072902. Lot one is 1.17 acres, lot two is 20 acres and lot three is 15 acres.
