

**DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
JUNE 11, 2018  
DALE MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m., with Supervisor Laabs, Supervisor Degal, Treasurer Sandy Noffke, Clerk Jenny DeZeeuw, Fire Chief and Building Inspector Jim Emmons and residents present.

Outagamie County Sheriff Deputies Hairil and Woods were present. They assured the Board that they have been patrolling and issuing citations to speeders on both Shaky Lake and School Roads. Because of road construction on Hwy 45 and 96 there is an increase in traffic on local roads.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve a certified survey map for Herb Schabo, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion that 2018 liquor, bartender and cigarette licenses as listed on the agenda and published in the Post Crescent be approved as long as all paperwork is in order and fees are paid, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve a temporary class "B" license for the Dale Fire and Rescue's June 30, 2018 fireworks celebration, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Supervisor Laabs made a motion to approve temporary bartender's licenses to be used at the Dale Fire and Rescue's June 30, 2018 fireworks celebration, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Fire Chief Emmons reported three calls; two first responder and one structure fire.

Building Inspector Emmons reported three new home permits were issued in May.

A certified survey map for Herb Schabo was reviewed at the June 4, 2018 Planning Commission Meeting.

The annual Dale Fireworks will be held June 30, 2018 at the Dale Municipal Building. This year's festivities will include a car and tractor parade, bean bag tournament, multiple raffles, food, drinks and fireworks at dusk.

Chairperson Wunderlich received a confirmation email that the Town will get an additional \$29,000 in TRIP money which will be used towards the second half of Midway Road construction in 2019.

A huge Thank You to all that came out to help with Park Work Day. Also, thank you to walking ladies, Evelyn Ruppel, Connie Thorson, Gladys Winckler, Vi Heuer, June Luebke and Cordell Schroeder for their generous donation which was used to purchase flowers for Daufen and Cornerstone Parks.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the minutes from May meetings, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

During public input Norm Kopesky introduced himself as one of the new owners of Vinny's Pizza. Norm and his brother Nate will take over July 1<sup>st</sup> and intend to keep the menu similar with the exception of eventually adding barbecue to the Sunday menu.

Chairperson Wunderlich made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit, seconded by Supervisor Degal, motion carried.

Treasurer Noffke reported that after discussion with the auditor, fire department payroll will be done in February and August.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to pay bills #17297-17333, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.

Supervisor Degal made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, motion carried.
